Theme "The theme was 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' and 'Enchanted Forest', with a colour scheme of pink, green, brown, gold and taupe," says Zoe. "I love fairies so this was also included as they feature in A Midsummer Night's Dream." The stunning theme was evident throughout the day, from the aisle flanked by large 15ft birch trees to the fairy decorations and even a fairy hunt for the guests! "They had to find 10 hidden fairies to win a prize," says Zoe. "The prizes were given out by two living statues – dressed as fairies!" 

Cake This was by Choccywoccydoodah (www.choccywoccydoodah.com). "It featured hand-carved chocolate fairies, acorns, ivy, roses, owls and toadstools," says Zoe.

Tables These were named after wild flowers. **Decoration** Birch trees or old-fashioned birdcages were used to decorate the tables.







Zoe's top tips

* "Instead of the usual table plan, Donna Michelle Designs (01376 562314) made a tree from willow branches and hung fairy lights and scrolls telling people where they were sitting." If your theme is inspired by nature, make unique table settings by writing guests' names on dried leaves or pretty pieces of slate.

* I hired games and cushions to keep guests comfortable and entertained during the drinks reception." If you want to add the fun factor to an outdoor reception, The Garden Game Company (www.thegardengame.co.uk) stocks everything from croquet sets to giant snakes and ladders.

* "We treated our overnight guests to cupcakes with icing flowers which we left on their pillows." If you're stuck for ideas on what to give as favours, cupcakes can be tailor-made to match your colour scheme.
